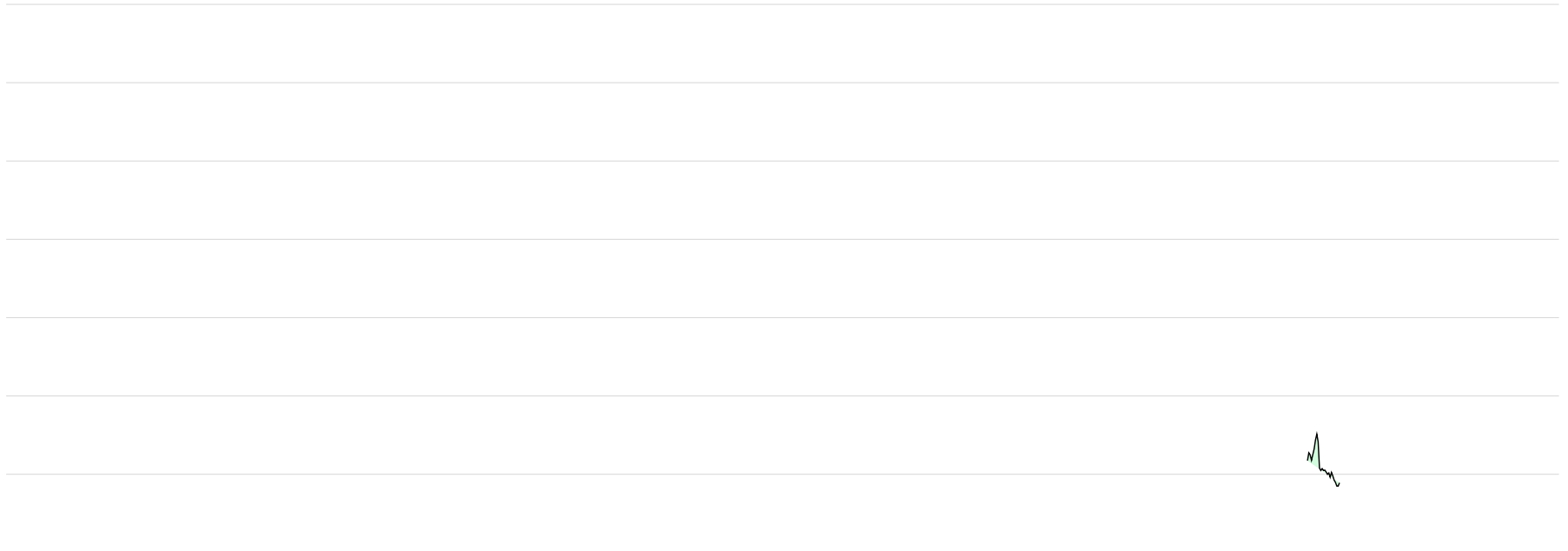




Patients with COVID-19 infection treated in a Corewell Health East Hospital



COVID-19 Infection = Patients who have COVID-19 confirmed infection. This includes those who have a positive COVID-19 lab test (positive) or clinical teams have marked them with a COVID-19 confirmed infection.

Definition Change = The average census line will **only reflect COVID Positive patients**. Suspected patient census can still be seen in the details page, but will not be displayed as part of the trend line.

Definition before 12/7/2022 - Patients who have COVID-19 confirmed or COVID-19 rule-out infection. This includes those who either have a recent positive COVID-19 lab test (positive), or are awaiting COVID-19 lab test results (pending), or have negative test but have COVID symptoms (not positive / not pending) and clinical teams have marked them with a COVID-19 confirmed infection or Contact & Enhanced Respiratory Isolation.

Positive = Patients with *COVID-19 confirmed* infection

Suspected = Patients with *COVID-19 rule-out* infection awaiting COVID-19 lab results and isolation orders for *Contact & Enhanced Respiratory*

Patients without an active *COVID-19 confirmed* infection or *Contact & Enhanced Respiratory* isolations, will not be counted
